

2009 Ponytail Softball Field Directions

Big Foot

Duck Pond A & B Fontana, Fontana

From Route 67- Turn west onto Wild Duck Rd , which is located in the middle of the large hill just north of the Village of Fontana. Take Wild Duck Rd straight past the Public Works Building and the water tower until the sign for Duck Pond Recreation Facility.

Toynton Park, Walworth

Enter into the Village of Walworth from either Route 67 or Route 14 to the town square (both roads will take you to the square) Go around the square turn right (west) onto Beloit Street (Walworth Grade School will be on your left once you turn) Take Beloit Street West for approximately ½ mile. Toynton Park will be on your left.

Lake Geneva

Veterans Park

Coming from Hwy 50 thru Lake Geneva, turn right onto Edwards Blvd (by Wal-Mart). Follow Edwards Blvd to Townline, take left on Townline Rd, Complex at end of park.

Coming from Hwy 12, get off at Lake Geneva exit; take right on top Hwy 50. Take left at stop light (Edwards Blvd) go to Townline Rd, take left. Complex at end of park.

Badger High School

The easiest way to Badger High School from the main intersection in Lake Geneva. Go due south on Wrigley Dr and it will turn into South Shore Dr. Go south for about 2 miles and turn left on South St. Once on South St., Badger will be about 3/4 of a mile on the right hand side.

Darien

West Park

Located on the north side of Darien, just off of Route 14, approximately ½ mile south of Route 43.

Elkhorn

Sunset Park

From Williams Bay, Take 67 North, turn left on Centralia St

From Lake Geneva, Take Hwy 12 North, take Hwy NN exit, turn left off NN, turn left on Hwy 67 (Lincoln St), turn right on Centralia St.

From Delavan, Take Hwy 11 east turn right on Devendorf St.

Harris Red Field

From Route 67 (north or south), turn east on Geneva Street. Turn left into Wright Street. Go one block north, and the field is on your right.
